Following the fall CAMTS Board meeting, the CAMTS Executive Staff participated in AMTC23 and presented a 4-hour workshop entitled Preparing for Accreditation. Mr. Chris Baker received the Peggy Calhoun Memorial Award for outstanding service in 2023 and was honored at the Site Surveyor breakfast during the conference.

During AMTC, the Ralph Rogers Scholarship Award for 2023 was awarded to Beka Thompson. Ms. Thompson is employed by the Arkansas Childrens Hospital – Angel One in Little Rock, AR.

In support of the Ralph Rogers Scholarship Fund – VRPatients donated an Oculus Virtual Gaming headset that was raffled in the Exhibit Hall during AMTC. Ms. Linda Meiner won the raffle.

To achieve accreditation by CAMTS, medical transport programs must adhere to CAMTS's standards, developed, and continually improved by a board of highly skilled and experienced medical and medical transportation professionals. Adherence to these standards, which are above and beyond regulatory requirements, are audited every three years to assure program compliance to remain accredited by CAMTS.
