- 1. **Succession planning?** You are "encouraged to develop a plan" for the absence of key positions. See standard 01.06.04 for examples of compliance.
- 2. **Green on green policy? Is it "avoid" or "prohibitive?" Which modes or levels?** For all modes and all levels, the standard reads "written policy addresses scheduling to avoid new employees working together." Green is often defined as one year.
- 3. **Never events vs. Near miss explanation** Never event- An event that should never occur however occurs despite risk assessment and preventive policies and practices. Near miss- An unplanned event that did not result in injury, illness, or damage- but had the potential to do so.
- 4. **HPS submission? What to I need to upload?** There is a written plan in the Education Matrix of the standards. Documents and one video is required.
- 5. For those nurses with CCRN & CEN do they need to take a transport-specific adv. certification? These are accepted until 2025 after which there must be a written plan in place for meeting the standard.
- 6. What is the definition of Long Range? *Long Range Flight defined as a flight requiring a planned tech stop on any patient leg, or in excess of 3 hours measured in time, not distance, because of winds, where there are no alternative capabilities for patient care needs or aviation operations.
- 7. **HROB team is on the unit, what clinical experience do they need?** Write objectives based on what they will need during transport and have them complete them on the unit.
- 8. CTRN & CFRN- Do they need both if both are in the scope? No- one is adequate!
- 9. **HROB team adv. Certification is not transport-specific.** RNC-OB meets compliance.
- 10. "Sea level pressurization of the cabin" in standard 06.02.02 was deleted from the final version. Sorry for the confusion.
- 11. Where are the addendums? Those are included with the purchased standards, in print or digital.
- 12. Who do we submit scenarios to yearly? You don't need to submit your scenarios yearly, but you will need a written example of each type of scenario in your PIF attachments.
- 13. **Is there a list of Never Events?** Yes, it is in Best Practice and if you email me, I'll send an example.
