Call to Order: Dr. Orr called the meetings to order at 1600 hours on February 9 and February 16.

Executive Board Report......Ms. Frazer

The Executive Board met on February 7, 2023 and interviewed Dr. Rob Holcomb who was recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) to be their CAMTS board representative. Dr. Holcomb currently directs Midwest Neonatal in Overland Park, an accredited neonatal-only service. Dr. Holcomb's experience includes conducting national and international pediatric & neonatal critical care transports in the military and serving as immediate past Chair of the AAP's Section on Transport Medicine. Dr. Holcomb is also the Chief Editor for the upcoming textbook 5<sup>th</sup> Edition: "Guidelines for Air and Ground Transport of Neonatal & Pediatric Patients". Dr. Holcomb was unanimously accepted as the new AAP representative.

The Executive Board voted to withdrew accreditation from a service that reported they experienced resignations from key managers and were currently not in service.

#### Ms. Frazer

Mr. D. Smith gave an update on the Site Surveyor training that was conducted January 27-29 in Dallas at AirBus Headquarters. Ms. Frazer, Ms. Eichel and Ms. Palmer joined Mr. Smith as faculty. Airborne Public Safety Association (APSA) auditors also joined for part of their training. Several pilots and two attendees with specific Mobile Integrated Health experience attended this class that is conducted approximately every two- three years, as needs arise.

#### Ms. J. Eichel

Ms. Eichel provided an update on the Ralph N. Rogers Award. Ms. Rebekah Thompson is the recipient of the award. Ms. Thompson is a Transport Nurse Manager for the Angel One service in Little Rock, Arkansas.

Ms. Eichel gave a Zoom workshop entitled "CAMTS 12<sup>th</sup> Edition – Are You Ready?" on February 28, 2023.
